Chef's Line® stuffed pastas are made with only the most authentic ingredients. The pasta dough is made with only flour and fresh eggs, which results in a firm bright yellow product. Each pasta has over 55% filling, resulting in a melt-in-your-mouth texture.

Heirloom Tomato and Burrata Mezzelune

The filling contains burrata and butter. Burrata mozzarella is filled with cream and comes from the Puglia region of Italy. In fact, burrata has been the fastest growing cheese variety over the last 4 years. Rich, sweet-roasted, heirloom tomatoes set off the cheese's creaminess perfectly. And, a hint of lemon brightens the overall flavor. Our mezzelune consist of 60% filling to 40% pasta.

Buffalo Milk Ricotta, Spinach and Rapini Tondi

Up to 70% filling, containing buffalo milk ricotta, butter, spinach, and a touch of rapini gives these tondi a modern twist. Buffalo milk, which is richer in protein, fat and minerals than cow's milk, is used to make this world's creamiest ricotta.
